109 families worked a total of 1601 hours during the 4 day event.
17 people worked a total of 58 hours on Thursday
40 people worked a total of 194 hours on Friday
164 people worked a total of 1031 hours on Saturday
77 people worked a total of 318 hours on Sunday
27 individuals each worked at least a 10 hour shift on Saturday, and
6 individuals worked all four days combining for an incredible 206 total hours worked.

The contributions (no matter how big or small) from ALL our volunteers are needed and greatly appreciated. There is no doubt the entire BSL team will once again step up to the challenge of Bubble Down. As the size of our competitive swim team grows, it can be expected that so too will the size of our volunteer base.
